

Daily Data

Daily Data is where you ask a specific question every week and follow a pattern throughout the week to extend the data.

Monday- Ask the question, and get the students to vote. TIP/Suggestion- Print student pictures small and make the backs of the pictures magnetic for them to move around an interactive voting board.

Tuesday- Have the students display the data in another way- ie. line plot, t-chart or tally chart.

Wednesday- Have the students write a journal entry using a 3-2-1 organizer- 3 observations of the data, 2 inferences and 1 variable that can change the data.

Thursday- Write a word and number problem involving the data.

Friday- Graph the data (ie. pie graph, bar graph)

Sample Daily Data Questions: (Provide four choices, if choices are needed)

- What is your favorite kind of soda?
- Does your first and last name combined have an even or odd amount of letters?
- What is your favorite song out of these choices- ____, ____, ____, or ____?
- Who is your favorite singer out of these choices?
- What is your favorite sport out of these choices?
- What is your favorite animal?
- What is your favorite story we have read in class?
- What is your favorite subject?
- If you could win a vacation to any of these places, which would you choose? (ie. Hawaii, New York City, Europe, or Alaska)
- What is your favorite breakfast food out of these- pancakes, French toast, waffles, or muffins?
- What is your favorite fruit?
- What is your favorite restaurant?
- How many brothers/sisters do you have? 0, 1, 2, or 3+
