

The Crazy Professor Game!

- Numbered by ones and twos
 - Rub your hands together and tell your neighbor, "I love the crazy professor game!"
1. **Read the passages you have been assigned to your partner.** Switch back and forth. Read them with a VERY dramatic voice.
 2. **Reread** the passage dramatically AND use your hands to express what is going on in the story.
 3. **TEACH YOUR NEIGHBOR:** Ask each other questions, using the dramatic voice and your hands.

Examples of questions:

- Who's the main character in the story?
- What's the story about?
- How was Akiak courageous?

4. **THE CRAZY PROFESSOR:** This is a big summary of what has been learned. There is the Crazy Professor and the Eager Student. The Crazy Professor gives an INTENSE summary of the story. They use gestures, props, and ask questions. They then say, "Tell me what I just said!" The Eager Student is just as excited- they encourage the Professor, answers questions, and repeats what they have learned. They say, "Tell me more! Yeah! I want more! C'mon! Tell me! Good job!" One person really wants to teach, and one person really wants to learn.

COOL: Reading dramatically helps you to emphasize key words and remember what you have learned.
