

This Is... Me.

This activity is going to take some time to reflect about who you were a few years ago compared to now. You need to gather a photo of yourself for this activity, but make it from either second or third grade, not fourth.

After you get the photo, write at least ten sentences explaining who you are today compared to a few years ago. Write on a different piece of paper where you attach your photo.

Think of questions like these as you are writing-

-Who were your closest friends then and now? Are they the same? Have you met anyone since then who has become a good friend?

-Who was your teacher that year, and how was school?

-Where was the photo taken?

-How have you changed on the outside? (Have you gotten taller? Is your hair the same?)

-How have you changed on the inside (become more outgoing, tried something new since then/developed a new hobby, got better at or grew to like a certain subject, tried a new sport, became more accepting/kind/showed your sense of humor more/etc.)?

Explain.

-(This is if you have siblings.) Has anyone new come into your family since then (the birth of a brother or sister, for example)? How old were your siblings when the photo was taken compared to now?




